

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK







The Serengeti, a stunning wildlife conservation area and Tanzania's prized possession in East Africa, covers an expansive 14,763 square kilometers of vast savannas and grasslands. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is renowned for the annual migration of millions of wildebeest and zebras. The park is home to a wide range of wildlife, including Africa's "Big Five" – lion, elephant, leopard, rhino, and buffalo – as well as cheetahs, hyenas, giraffes, various antelope species, and more. The Serengeti showcases a variety of landscapes from grasslands to savannas and wooded hills



NGORONGORO CRATER:

Located approximately
180 kilometers west of Arusha,
this UNESCO World Heritage
Site is a vast volcanic caldera
with breathtaking scenery. It is
widely recognized as one of the
most stunning tourist
destinations in Africa, renowned
for its rich wildlife and



remarkable landscapes. With a width of about 20 kilometers, the crater is home to a diverse range of animals, including the Big Five (lion, elephant, leopard, rhino, buffalo), zebras, wildebeest, and cheetahs. The lakes within the crater are adorned with flamingos and other water birds, adding to the vibrant environment. The Ngorongoro Crater is an essential conservation area in Africa, offering a unique ecosystem that marvels at nature and conservation.



TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

The protected and preserved wildlife sanctuaryin Tanzania, situated in the northern part of the country, about 118 kilometers southwest of Arusha. This 2,850-square-kilometer area is famous for its abundant and diverse wildlife, particularly largeherds of elephants, as well as a rich variety of animals such as lions, leopards, zebras, and a stunning array of birds.

The landscape of the park is characterized by the Tarangire River, after which Tarangire National Park is named. This river sustains numerous animals during the dry season and is home to a large population of hippopotamuses and crocodiles. In addition to observing wildlife, visitors can enjoy a range of outdoor activities including game drives, guided walks, and night game drives.



LAKE EYASI

Lake Eyasi is a stunning salt lake in the northern part of Tanzania, bordering Kenya, offering a glimpse into a bygone era. Here, the indigenous Hadzabe and Datoga communities thrive, preserving their ancestral customs for centuries. Cultural activities at Lake Eyasi mainly revolve around learning about



the unique lifestyles, traditions, and practices of these indigenous communities. Visitors can witness and take part in activities with the Hadzabe, the last hunter-gatherers in Africa, practicing their age-old way of life. Learn about medicinal plants, join a hunt, witness, and participate in captivating traditional dance and music performances. Observe the Datoga, skilled metalworkers, and their artistry in crafting jewelry, pottery-making skills, and intricate bead-work. Lake Eyasi offers a journey into Tanzania's rich cultural tapestry.



LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

Located in the northern part of Tanzania, adjacent to the town of Mto wa Mbu, is a protected area known as Lake Manyara National Park. Covering 330 square kilometers, this park is famous for its diverse wildlife and stunning landscapes. The focal point of the park is a shallow alkaline lake, which serves as a sanctuary for

flamingos and other waterbirds. In addition to the iconic wildlife such as elephants, giraffes, hippos, baboons, and various species of antelope, visitors can also spot tree-climbing lions resting in acacia trees. Apart from wildlife viewing, the park offers opportunities for outdoor activities like birding, hiking, and canoeing.



MOUNT KILIMANJARO:

Kilimanjaro, Africa's tallest peak and one of the most renowned in the world, is a dormant volcano with a snow-capped summit visible from afar. Situated in northern Tanzania, near the town of Moshi, it reaches a height of 5,895 meters above sea level. Comprising three



volcanic cones - Kibo, Mawenzi, and Shira - Kilimanjaro is visible from a distance on clear days. Despite its impressive height, the mountain is a popular destination for climbers due to its accessibility, drawing trekkers from around the globe each year. The ascent is demanding and requires good physical condition and acclimatization to the altitude.



ZANZIBAR:

Zanzibar is a semi-autonomous archipelago in Tanzania, located off the coast of East Africa. It comprises two main islands, Unguja and Pemba, along with several smaller ones. The archipelago is renowned for its beautiful beaches and rich history. Stone Town, the capital, is a UNESCO World Heritage site featuring narrow streets, historic architecture,

and bustling markets. Zanzibar is also known for its production of spices such as cloves, nutmeg, and cinnamon, which have been cultivated for centuries. In addition to its cultural and historical significance, Zanzibar offers a variety of outdoor activities such as snorkeling, diving, and fishing, making it an ideal destination for beach lovers.



MIKUMI NATIONAL PARK;

Mikumi National Park is a sprawling 3,230 sq km wildlife reserve in southern Tanzania, offering an easily accessible wildlife spectacle just a few hour's drive from Dar es Salaam. As part of the vast Selous ecosystem, this park is home to a diverse range of wildlife, including herds of



elephants, zebras, and buffaloes, as well as graceful giraffes. Predators like lions and leopards lurk a midst the landscapes, while over 400 bird species fill the skies, adding to the park's diversity. The park is ideal for game drives, guided walks, and camping safaris, making it a popular destination for tourists seeking a safari experience in Tanzania.



NYERERE NATIONAL PARK

Nyerere National Park, formerly known as Selous Game Reserve, is a protected area located in southern Tanzania. Spanning over 30,000 sq km, it is Africa's largest wildlife sanctuary. It was renamed in honor of Tanzania's first president, Julius Nyerere, in 2019. The park is home to a diverse array of wildlife and landscapes, from savannas to the mightyRufiji River. Visitors can enjoy

game drives, boat safaris, or guided walking safaris and witness the way of life and learn from the rich culture of local communities.

Nyerere National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is recognized as an important conservation area due to its rich and unique ecosystem teeming with life and biodiversity.



RUAHA NATIONAL PARK:

Tanzania's largest national park, Ruaha National Park, is a protected area located in East Africa known for its rugged and wild terrain. The landscape features rolling hills, rocky outcrops, and open plains covering an area of approximately 22,000 square kilometers. Named after the



Great Ruaha River that winds through the park, it attracts a diversity of wildlife such as giraffes, zebras, elephants, lions, leopards, and cheetahs. This sanctuary also protects over 570 bird species, including the endemic Ruaha red-billed hornbill and the African fish eagle. Conservation efforts ensure that this wildlife paradise thrives through its various programs.



UDZUNGWA NATIONAL PARK:

Udzungwa National Park is a protected area located in Tanzania, East Africa.

Nestled within the Eastern Arc Mountains, this 1,990 sq km park includes the Udzungwa Mountains, which are known for their steep slopes, waterfalls, and stunning views. It is a haven comprising an ancient mountain chain, home to unique flora and fauna, some of which are found nowhere else on Earth. Udzungwa National Park

is a popular destination for hiking and trekking, offering several trails through lush forests where visitors can encounter cascading waterfalls and marvel at breathtaking mountain views. The park is also an important site for scientific research, particularly in the fields of ecology, botany, and zoology. Udzungwa is a top attraction, making it a must-visit for nature enthusiasts and adventure seekers, whether you're an avid trekker or a curious explorer.



EXCURSIONS MTO WA MBU:

Situated near the entrance to
Lake Manyara National Park,
Mto wa Mbu is a village in
Tanzania that boasts a vibrant
cultural scene. The village is
known for its rich cultural heritage
and diverse ethnic groups,
making it a hub for cultural
activities such as:Cultural tours:
Visitors can take guided tours of



the village, which typically include visits to local homes, farms, schools, and markets. Art and crafts: Mto wa Mbu is home to many talented artists and artisans who create a wide range of traditional crafts, including bead work, carving, and weaving. Visitors can purchase these items as souvenirs or participate in workshops to learn how to make them. A Maasai boma visit offers visitors a chance to experience the unique culture and lifestyle of the Maasai people, semi-nomadic pastoralists living in East Africa. During a visit, guests are welcomed into a traditional Maasai village to witness daily life and learn about their culture and traditions. Visitors can watch men perform traditional dances, observe women crafting intricate bead work, and explore traditional homes made of cow dung and mud. Masai Boma Music and Dance: The village is renowned for its vibrant music and dance scene, with regular traditional performances. Visitors can observe or participate in workshops to learn traditional dances.



A MAASAI BOMA VISIT;

A chance to experience the unique Maasai culture with a visit to a traditional boma (village), During a Maasai boma visit, visitors are welcomed into a traditional Maasai village to Witness daily life of these semi-nomadic pastoralists firsthand as well as culture and traditions. Watch warriors perform powerful dances, learn about bead-work from the

women, and explore authentic dwellings built with natural materials comprising of cow dung and mud. Gain a deeper appreciation for the Maasai way of life on this unique cultural experience.





OLDUVAI GORGE:

Olduvai Gorge, also known as Oldupai Gorge, is a dramatic steep-sided ravine in Tanzania's Great Rift Valley and is one of the most important archaeological sites in the world. Dating back 1.8 million years, it holds fossils and stone tools that provide valuable insights into the story of early humans and their evolving culture. With evidence of human activity from

the Lower Paleolithic to the present day, this active research site continues to unlock the secrets of our ancestors through the work of archaeologists, paleontologists, and other scientists.

SAMPLE ITINERARIES:

5- DAYS MARANGU ROUTE

Day 0: Arrival and briefing Arrive in Tanzania at Kilimanjaro Airport and drive to Moshi, get a Kilimanjaro briefing from our professional Mountain guide.

Day 1: Marangu gate (1830 m) – Mandara huts (2740 m)Hike through the montane forest to Mandara Huts for acclimatization.

Day 2: Mandara Huts (2740 m) – Horombo Huts (3690 m) Ascend through the moorland zone to Horombo Huts for further acclimatization.

Day 3: Horombo Huts (3690 m)-Kibo Huts (4695 m) Trek across the alpine desert to Kibo Huts, positioned for the summit push

Day 4: Kibo Huts (4695 m) – Uhuru Peak (5895 m)– Horombo Huts (3690 m) Summit Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa, before descending to Horombo Huts.

Day 5: Horombo Huts (3690 m)- Marangu gate (1830 m)-Moshi/ Arusha Descend back to the park gate and depart for Moshi or Arusha.

Day 0: Departure transfer to Airport for your flight









6 DAYS MACHAME ROUTE

Day 0: Arrival and briefing Arrive in Tanzania at Kilimanjaro Airport and drive to Moshi, get a Kilimanjaro briefing from our professional Mountain guide

Day 1: Machame Gate (1790m) - Machame camp (3010 m) Hike through the rainforest to Machame Camp

Day 2: Machame camp (3010m) - Shira camp (3845 m) Ascend to Shira Camp on the Shira Plateau.

Day 3: Shira camp (3845 m) – Lava tower (4640 m)– Barranco camp (3960 m) Challenge yourself with Lava Tower climb before reaching Barranco Camp

Day 4: Barranco camp (3960 m)- Barafu camp (4640 m) Trek to Barafu Camp, the high camp for the summit push.

Day 5: Barafu camp (4640 m)- Uhuru peak (5895 m)-Mweka camp (3080 m)Summit Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa, then descend to Mweka Camp.

Day 6: Mweka camp (3080 m)- Mweka Gate (1630 m) – Arusha/Moshi Descend through the forest back to the Mweka Gate and depart for Arusha/Moshi.

Day 0: Departure transfer to Airport for your flight

MOUNT KILIMANJARO TREK PACKAGES

SAMPLE ITINERARIES:

8 DAYS LEMOSHO ROUTE

Day 0: Arrival and briefing Arrive in Moshi, Tanzania, the gateway to Kilimanjaro, and get briefed for your exciting climb.

Day 1: Lemosho Gate (2,250m) – Big Tree Camp (2,780 m) Enter Kilimanjaro National Park through Lemosho Gate and trek through the lush rainforest to Big Tree Camp.

Day 2: Big Tree Camp (2,780m) – Shira Camp 1 (3,750m) Ascend through Shira Plateau's scenic moorland, reaching a higher altitude at Shira Camp 1.

Day 3: Shira Camp 1 (3,750m) – Shira Camp 2 (3900m) Ascend through Shira Plateau's scenic moorland, reaching a higher altitude at Shira Camp 2

Day 4: Shira Camp 2 (3,900m) - Barranco Camp (3,960m) Hike across the plateau, passing the unique volcanic feature, Lava Tower, before reaching Barranco Camp.

Day 5: Barranco Camp (3,960m) – Karanga Camp (4,035m) Traverse the dramatic Barranco Wall, a challenging yet rewarding section, and arrive at Karanga Camp.

Day 6: Karanga Camp (4,035m) – Barafu Camp (4,640m) Conquer a relatively short climb to Barafu Camp, the high camp for your summit push.


Day 7: Barafu Camp (4,640m) – Uhuru Peak (5,895m)– Mweka Camp (3,080m) Summit day! Hike through the night to Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa, and descend to Mweka Camp for rest.

Day 8: Mweka Camp (3,080m) – Arusha/Moshi Celebrate your achievement and trek down to Mweka Gate, departing for Moshi.


